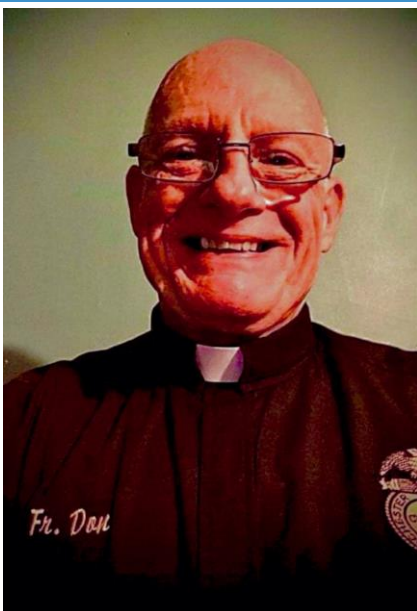




WHO IS INTERESTED IN ATTENDING NATIONAL POLICE WEEK?
