How many Irondequoit Residents? Talk about SMART Camera program tracks where cameras are located. Also tracks parolees, probationers, and sex offenders.

The September newsletter had a link to questions related to the updated gun laws. Difficult keeping up with since laws keep changing Concealed carry Improvement Act- requires people seeking concealed carry permits to show they have good moral character, provide character references, contact info of family members/people they live with, social media accounts. There's now a requirement effective 09/01/22 if you leave your gun unattended in a vehicle it must be unloaded and in a fire impact and tamper resistant storage box that is not in plain view. This doesn't include a glove compartment or glove box.

Recently, A Federal Judge in NY temporarily blocked parts of the state's revised carry gun laws finding that it was too strict and should not have barred weapons from being carried in areas like public playgrounds, health care facilities, libraries, and houses of worship.
