



RECIPE CORNER

Caprese Pasta Salad

Ingredients:

- 1 pound pasta (rotini, penne, or your favorite shape)
- 1-pint cherry tomatoes, halved
- 8 ounces fresh mozzarella balls (bocconcini) halved or quartered
- ¼ cup fresh basil leaves, chopped
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 2 tablespoons balsamic vinegar
- Salt & pepper to taste

Instructions:

- 1. Cook pasta according to package directions. Drain and rinse with cold water.
- 2. In a large bowl, combine cooked pasta, tomatoes, mozzarella, and basil.
- 3. In a small bowl, whisk together olive oil, balsamic vinegar, salt, and pepper.
- 4. Pour dressing over pasta salad and toss to combine.
- 5. Serve immediately or chill for later.
